

Maybank Islamic Centre of Excellence Shares their Expertise in a Knowledge-Sharing Session with Trustbank Amanah

Maybank Islamic Centre of Excellence conducted a knowledge-sharing session on Islamic Finance for Trustbank Amanah, the first Islamic bank in Suriname, South America from 23 to 25 July 2018 at its head office in Dataran Maybank, Kuala Lumpur.

The 3-day forum which was co-organised with Islamic Corporation for the Development of the Private Sector (ICD) covered topics such as banking products, Shariah governance and financial reporting.

Trustbank Amanah was officially converted to a full-fledged Islamic bank in December 2017 after twenty-eight years of operation. The Trustbank Amanah delegates were led by its Chief Executive Officer Ms. Maureen Badjoeri. The session was also attended by En Noorazmi Mohd Razalli, Regional Manager (Asia) from ICD.
